Dear OT Golfers,

Happy New Year and I hope you all had a great Christmas and New Year. If you haven't read the minutes of the last AGM, which was held at Reigate Heath GC in August last year (a copy can be read off the OTGS website <u>www.oldtauntoniangs.org</u>) you will notice Richard Jowett has stepped down as secretary and I have taken up the reins. In so doing I have stepped down as Captain and handed over that responsibility to the very capable Peter Whalley. I huge thank you goes out to Richard J for the many years he has been the backbone of this society. In November last year Terry kindly hosted a small gathering and lunch so that we could present Richard J with a collage of Le Touquet, which both he and Gill enjoy and attended for many years (always the few days before the Halford Hewitt week) with golfing stalwarts of the OTGS.

2022 was a normal year for fixtures uninterrupted by covid etc! We had a fantastic turnout at Swinley, thanks to David Murrell, so much so that we will have to adhere to maximum numbers stipulated by Swinley this year. In the Hewitt, the team made it to the 2nd round of the main competition having beaten three times finalists Ampleforth, to the surprise of many, only to be defeated by Malvern. Unfortunately, OTGS performance in the Brent Knoll Bowl, Grafton Morris qualifier and Cyril Gray was below par! The local West events in 2022 were again well attended, thanks to Hugh Todd.

Golf at the school appears to be moving out of the doldrums. Driven by Liam Dempster his key points are; *TS have entered a league with 5 other local independent schools, which was a great success last year and is due to be run again this coming season. Handicap matches which allow us to engage more golfers. Other entries for the coming season are the HMC Foursomes and the ISGA Matchplay competitions. We have been invited back to the Burnham and Berrow competition this year. Golf is now an option in the main games programme at school for pupils in Years 11-13. We are also looking at putting it into a programme for those in Years 9+10 this year. Plans are in place for a golf simulator to be built at school this coming year, subject to planning permission and other necessary details going through. So, this is great news.*

Once again, we held the OTGS AGM at the Reigate Heath GC meeting and for those who couldn't attend in person we had Zoom. As mentioned above the minutes are on the website, all the officials were re-elected again except Secretary and Captain.

Our finances remain secure thanks to the guiding hand of Richard Norris. However, with the ever increasing cost of entering the scratch competitions we have started to ask those selected to contribute to at least 50% of the costs. This still represents great value given the courses we play.
